## 4.3 Precept 2021-2022

A detailed discussion took place using the spread sheet presented to the Council by Cllr. Charles which was based on discussions with the finance group. (please see attached)

The focus of the discussion was to agree the forthcoming precept balancing the demands on the finances and the issues raised by parishioners and Councillors. As a result of this discussion priorities were agreed.

Agreed: The Precept to be increased by 15% which, using the current NKDC 2021-2022 calculator would mean an estimated additional cost of £9.28 per year on Band D (£0.77pence per month)

This increase was agreed after serious consideration given to the costs of ensuring health and safety is maintained to the required standard and the cost of replacing the piece of equipment in the park.

A site inspection had highlighted the need to undertake work on the trees around the park. The costs of this work will be shared with the Mary Kings Trust. Cllr. Barrie confirmed that the quote received included the costs for all the work and the Parish Council contribution would be circa £1200.

Agreed: Work to be undertaken by the Tree Surgeon as soon possible subject to the confirmation of the costs to the Parish Council up to the value of £1200.

The cost of parts to repair and make good the play equipment as required by the independent ROSPA safety report will be ordered at a cost of £2295.90 (plus vat). Parish councillors will however fit and make the necessary repairs as a cost saving exercise for the Parish.

Agreed: This work to be undertaken asap.

The finance group had considered the options for the replacement of the Park Equipment and had concluded that purchase and fitting of the Swingo at a cost of £4026 was the best option.
